The Haverford Township Board of Commissioners invites the public to join them in the ceremonial groundbreaking for the construction of a new combined Municipal Services Building on Saturday, June 11, 2016 at 9 AM. The ceremony will take place at the site of the current Haverford Police facility, 1010 Darby Road, Havertown, PA 19083, near the intersection with Manoa Road.

“We are excited that the construction coincides with the centennial anniversary month and year of the formation of the Haverford Police Department,” said Board President Chris Connell, Sr. “This new facility combines the Township Police, Administration, and Park and Recreation Offices under a single roof, and creates a much larger meeting space for public meetings.”

The new 43,000 square foot facility will be added to the existing campus that houses the Police, the Township of Haverford Skatium and the Veterans Memorial Park. Also maintained on site are several playfields. The site adjoins a multi-purpose trail that connects the facility to several neighborhoods and Eagle Road at the YMCA. The building is scheduled for late fall 2017 occupancy.
