

PECO to Begin DAY & EVENING Road Closures on Eagle Road on Monday, June 19

June 14, 2017

Peco advised the Township *today* that construction will begin on Eagle Road - from St. Denis Lane to Darby Road (by Katz Pharmacy) - starting Monday morning, June 19, 2017. *The project will be completed during day and evening hours, depending on the location of the work.*

Daytime Construction will occur **from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.** from St. Denis Lane to Clover Lane. During the construction, all traffic will be detoured down Earlington Road, to Brookline Boulevard, and back to Eagle Road, with limited access allowed to the construction area for local residents. Peco has not provided Haverford Township with an estimated completion date for this portion of the project.

Evening Construction will occur **from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.** from Clover Lane to Darby Road (by **Katz Pharmacy**). All traffic will be detoured down Earlington Road, to Brookline Boulevard, and back to Eagle Road, with limited access allowed to the construction area for local residents. Peco estimates that this portion of the project will last 3 to 5 weeks.

Because the construction is only on a state road (Eagle Road), Haverford Township has no input into the timing of the construction or the road closures. PennDOT is solely responsible for and has made all decisions relating to this project.

Final restoration and repaving of Eagle Road will begin after completion of the construction, weather permitting. Any properties impacted by the construction will be repaired and restored to their original condition by the Peco contractor, Infrasource Construction, which can be reached at (610) 757-6709.
