Haverford Township EAC Logo Contest

In summer planning for Haverford Township Day, the members of the Township's Environmental Advisory Committee (EAC) decided a logo would enhance an EAC banner meant to advertise their booth. "A banner is just better with a logo. We could let the children help to design our logo!" declared Jan Marie Rushforth, EAC Chair. The EAC logo art contest was born.

The role of the Haverford Township Environmental Advisory Committee is to advise the Board of Commissioners and the Township Manager on environmental issues, and to serve as a resource for township residents on ecology and pollution problems.

The 2012 EAC Logo contest invited students from around the Township to submit their own visions of Environmental Art. What a fun and creative way for children to think about our fragile planet, and to express their own views and suggestions!

EAC members Mrs. Terry Watkins of the Hilltop section and architect Dave Hartke both ran with the EAC Logo Contest. They visited several Summer Haverford Recreation Center Camps to invite students to create their own Environmental Art. About 20 children created environmental art drawings for the EAC Logo Contest. Deciding on a winner was challenging, because there were several colorful and meaningful submissions. Ultimately, the clockwise circular motion of green arrows surrounding the Earth cinched the decision for Nolan




Hartke to be the vouth winner. Nolan's art also included the yellow sun radiating on solar Photo Voltaic Panels to generate electricity, and a tree with flowers including their roots with encouragement to not cut trees. concern over burning coal or use of oil, and a goal to "save the World" were also

expressed in Nolan's art submission.

Nolan will receive a Bowling Party from Wynnewood Lanes (a bowling party for 12 to 15 people for 3 lanes

including shoe rentals for a party between May and August 2013) and a \$25 gift certificate from C & M Sporting Goods at Manoa Shopping Center for his winning entry.

Nolan's Dad captured the requests of EAC, with the



inspiration from Nolan's art. and David Hartke designed and hand drew a final EAC logo. The logo for the banner fills those green arrows around the world with actions that our Haverford Township EAC confronts: Conserve, Outreach, Plant Trees, Recycle, Save Energy,

Storm Water, and Solar Energy.

Each of the students will receive 2 Bowling Admissions from Wynnewood Lanes on Haverford Road, Havertown, along with a State Coloring Book, a Picture book about the Harrisburg State Capitol, and 2 maps, provided by State Rep Greg Vitali.

The Board of Commissioners recognized the children's art creations at their meeting on Tuesday, November 13, 2013 with a Proclamation read by Third Ward Commissioner Jane Hall. About 18 children and their parents attended to show off their art and receive their prizes.
