Dear Mr. Gentile:

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation has awarded a \$2,282,490 contract to Clearwater Construction, Inc., of Mercer, Pennsylvania, to replace the bridge carrying Manoa Road over Cobbs Creek in Haverford Township, Delaware County. The project is scheduled to finish in the fall of 2019.

Construction is expected to start this spring to replace the 34-foot-long, 45-foot-wide single-span T-beam bridge built in 1929. The new structure will be a 34-foot-long, 41-foot-wide, single-span prestressed concrete bulb-tee bridge with two 11-foot lanes, two 9-foot shoulders, and a 6-foot sidewalk on the upstream side of the structure. The scope of work also includes improvements to the drainage system, guide rail repair, and milling and overlaying the approaches. The structure is in poor condition and currently posted for 25 tons and 33 tons for combination vehicles.

During construction, Manoa Road will be closed and detoured. During this time, motorists will be directed to use Earlington Road, U.S. 1 (City Avenue/Township Line Road), and Haverford Road.

The construction phase of this project is financed with 100 percent state funds.

Thank you for your support of this important transportation improvement project in Delaware County.
