Position: Skate Guard  
Minimum Qualifications: Must be minimum 16 years of age and a proficient skater (Ice hockey or figure skating background preferable)

Requirements:

- Ability to skate under control and perform basic skating skills
- Must work weekends during the fall and winter seasons as well as holidays
- Participation as staff during public skating and private events
- If selected three clearances will be required prior to employment. A criminal background check, child abuse clearance and \*FBI clearance/fingerprinting.

Duties:

- Responsible for the overall safety of patrons during public sessions and private events
- Perform constant surveillance of the ice rink conditions and patrons during public skating hours
- Advise on duty supervisor of potential hazards
- Perform general cleaning of the rink before, during and after public skating

It is hereby declared to be public policy of Haverford Township to foster the employment of all individuals in accordance with their fullest capacities regardless of race, color, religious creed, ancestry, age, sex, national origin, handicap or disability, use of guide or support animals because of the blindness, deafness or physical handicap of the user or because the user is a handler or trainer of support or guide animals, or because of a person's sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression.

\*Employees under the age of 18 are required to have the FBI clearance if they cannot satisfy the following requirements;  
(1) Minor employee has been a resident of the commonwealth of PA during the entirety of the previous 10-year period or, if not a resident of Pennsylvania during the entirety of the previous 10-year period, has received an FBI clearance at any time since establishing residency in the commonwealth.  
(2) the employee and their parents or legal guardian swear and affirm in writing that the minor child/employee are not disqualified from service under the grounds for denying employment or have not been convicted of an offense similar in nature to those crimes under the laws or former laws of the United States or one of its territories or possessions, another state, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico or foreign nation, or under a former law of this commonwealth.
