## DO RECYCLE

### GLASS

- Food & Beverage Jars & Bottles (Clear, brown, & green)

### METAL (Aluminum, Steel & Bi-Metal)

- Food Containers
- Beverage Cans
- Empty Aerosol Cans

*Remove caps/lids, rinse. You do not have to remove labels.*

### PLASTICS

- Containers Labeled #1 - #7

*Remove caps/lids, rinse. You don't have to remove labels or neck rings.*

### PAPER, CARDBOARD & PAPERBOARD (Dry)

- Newspapers, Inserts and Junk Mail
- Magazines, Catalogs, Envelopes
- Cardboard Boxes (All Sizes) (Flatten & tie all corrugated boxes)
- Food Boxes (e.g., crackers, cereal, cake boxes)
- Paper Towel & Toilet Paper Rolls (Empty)
- Paperboard Packaging (e.g., tissue boxes)
- Office & School Paper/Copy Paper (Any color)
- Paper Bags & Grocery Bags
- Phone Books & Other Soft Cover Books

## DO NOT RECYCLE

### GLASS

- Broken Glass
- Drinking Glasses
- Light Bulbs
- Windows

### METAL

- Electronics
- Batteries
- Mirrors
- Scrap Metal
- Ceramics
- Needles

### PAPER

### PIZZA BOXES

- Wet Paper
- Wet Cardboard
- Waxy/Coated Cardboard

### PLASTICS

- Food-Soiled Materials
- Plastic Bags
- Plastic Grocery Bags
- Tableware (e.g. knives & forks)
- Toys
- Sporting Goods
- Tubs, Cups & Trays
- Tupperware
- Disposable Containers
- Polystyrene Cups or Plates
- Styrofoam
- Solvents, Oil & Other Chemical Containers
- Swimming Pools
- Trash Cans
- Hangers
- Fencing

*•DO NOT recycle styrofoam, bubble wrap, packing peanuts or other packing materials*

## WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT IN THE TRASH! DO NOT RECYCLE!

**BRUSH GUIDELINES:** 3 Feet or Less in Length, Tied, Less Than 40 Pounds Per Bundle; No Plastic Bags

*Nothing should be sticking out of any trash can for worker safety*
